4.1	Interpretation of CFP quantification results	• CO2 emission in Use & maintenance stage is the second largest as 24%. It is important to save energy during product usage and to make the life time of consumables longer. The condition in this CFP evaluation can be different from the one which the user operates under. A choice of the use condition (print mode, print conditions and so on) can reduce the CO ₂ emission during Use & maintenance stage.			
		•We evaluated the CFP with Canon's own data of raw materials weight and the general basic unit for the parts because it is difficult to collect the data for a couple of thousands of parts. Accordingly, the results may be different from the specific product specification. As such, please be advised that this result would be a rough estimate.
