Rules on registration and assessment of licensed reviewer

Established on April 2, 2012

<Purpose>

Article 1

This document shall prescribe the rules on registration and release of licensed reviewer under the CFP Communication Program (hereinafter called “the CFP Program” operated and managed by JEMAI (Japan Environmental Management Association for Industry). Licensed reviewer in this document refers to CFP-PCR reviewer and CFP verifier.

<Audit for registration>

Article 2

Licensed reviewer shall register as a reviewer with JEMAI for conducting a review. When registering, the licensed reviewer shall undergo an audit for the confirmation of fulfilling the requirements for registration of licensed reviewer.

<Requirements for registration of licensed reviewer>

Article 3

Requirements for registration of licensed reviewer shall be prescribed in the “Requirements for competence of licensed reviewer.”

<Judgment criteria on registration of licensed reviewer>

Article 4

Judgment criteria for registration as a reviewer shall be prescribed in the “Judgment criteria on registration of licensed reviewer.”

< Procedures for registration and assessment of licensed reviewer>

Article 5

Procedures for registration and assessment of licensed reviewer shall be prescribed in the "Procedures for registration and assessment of licensed reviewer."

<Validity period of registration of licensed reviewer>

Article 6

The validity period of registration of licensed reviewer shall be one year. When a licensed reviewer wishes to continue the registration, the licensed reviewer shall apply for renewal to JEMAI.

<Surveillance>

Article 7

In the case that JEMAI judged the surveillance is necessary, JEMAI can confirm the results of works conducted by the licensed reviewer.

<Revocation of registration>

Article 8

When it is confirmed that a licensed reviewer violates any of the requirements for licensed reviewer, JEMAI can revoke the registration of the licensed reviewer.

Supplementary provisions

This document shall come to effect as from April 2, 2012.
